

THE FIRST STEPS

RE-ACT partners met in Porto in January 2020 to kick off the project and decide on the first steps, which were impacted (and to some extent delayed) due to the pandemic. However, the partners still contacted actors from the quadruple helix to underpin their collaborative work for smart specialisation strategies. At the same time, partners discussed the best ways to translate the potential of HEINNOVATE for RIS3 into an upgraded online self-assessment tool.

CURRENT STATUS

In the last few months, partners have conducted an extensive research analysis (including Literature Review, Delphi Study and Interviews) involving experts from HEINNOVATE and S3 and public authorities leading RIS3 processes at regional and national level. The results of this analysis were discussed during the 2nd partners' meeting, on 14th of October.

NEXT STEPS

RE-ACT's partners are currently finalising the Research Report (with results from the Literature Review, Delphi Study, and Interviews). After this stage, validation workshops will be organised to collect feedback from key stakeholders on the research findings and key takeaways. In total, 75 regional actors will be invited to participate (15 per workshop, including 5 HEIs, 5 industry representatives and 5 local authorities/policy makers). The inputs collected in the workshops will be gathered and considered for the development of the Guidelines for HEINNOVATE for RIS3.
