RE-ACT self-assessment tool

The RE-ACT project started by investigating the potential of creating a tool for Higher Education Institutions to assess their role at regional level. After a detailed desk and field research, conclusions fed the development of the RE-ACT Self-Assessment tool.

Research Activities

- Cross-analysis to investigate the potential of the creating a self-assessment tool.
 Sources: Literature Review (LR), Delphi method, interviews.
- The research report (available on the project website) draws the most important conclusions of the different research methods in order to support the development of the tool.

Development of the tool

- Elaboration of statements describing the higher education institutions' (HEIs') contribution to Research and Innovation Strategies for Smart Specialisation (RIS3)
- Validation of statements in workshops.
- Deployment of the tool online and testing.



Self-Assessment Tool

- Based on the concept of collaboration among the actors of the Quadruple Helix, this tool allows HEIs to self-reflect and assess their contribution to RIS3, helping them to understand, among other issues, how well they fulfil their mission and reach out to others.
